Parker Farmer's Market: Sundays, May 3rd through the end of October, weather permitting

Southland Farmer's Market: Saturdays, May 9th through October 18th weather permitting
9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. <-<- New Times

At the intersection of Smoky Hill Road and E470 in the Southlands Retail Center in Aurora, in the main plaza in front of the cinema.

Northfield Stapleton Farmer's Market: Saturdays, May 16th through end of October, weather permitting.
8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Located in the bustling Northfield Stapleton shopping center at I-70 and Quebec. VERY, VERY BUSY CENTER! No onsite 'restaurant style' cooking will be allowed here (sampling is fine).

The Orchards Farmer's Market: Sundays, May 17th through end of October, weather permitting. 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Located in The Orchards shopping center at I-25 and 144th. This center has been getting steady business and is doing very well in its first year.

No onsite 'restaurant style' cooking will be allowed here (sampling is fine).

Lonetree Farmer's Market: Saturdays, May 23rd through October 10th 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
The market will be held in the Lonetree Entertainment District. Nice increase in market sales at our new location in 2008. No onsite 'restaurant style' cooking will be allowed here in 2009 (sampling is fine).

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Parker Farmer's Market Additional Information:

As with the 2008 season, TCFM will again institute the following rule for 2009:

If a TCFM vendor chooses to participate in any other farmers market or an event similar to a farmer's market that is located within the Town of Parker, that is not operated by TCFM or is in direct competition with the market managed by TCFM, they will be exempt from participating in any TCFM operated markets and will forfeit any and all monies paid for the 2009 season.

This rule will be strictly enforced.

SPECIAL TAX NOTICE FOR PARKER FARMER'S MARKET VENDORS:

Due to the fact that the Town of Parker could not collect taxes from several vendors who refused to pay their 3% tax directly to the Town in a timely manner, I am now required to collect a 3% tax from each and every one of you on a monthly basis. What does this mean? This means that all vendors at the market will be paying me on the first Sunday of each month for the sales tax that they collected the prior month, and I will be turning the taxes into the Town of Parker for you. On the good side, you will no longer be required to obtain a Parker Business license prior to the start of the season. Let me know if you have ANY questions regarding this new requirement.

Per the Town of Parker, the above tax information will be confirmed in March of 2009. Information will be given in confirmation letters prior to the start of the market.

We will again have the \$25 minimum for the Parker Farmer's Market in 2009. If any of you have any questions with regards to the Parker Farmer's Market, please do not hesitate to get in touch with me.

- Full Time Application Fees are \$100 total for one market, \$150 total for two markets, \$200 for 3 markets, \$250 for 4 markets , \$350 for 5 markets (If you participate in the Saturday Southlands, do not count the Thursday Southlands in your total).
- All market daily fees are 10%, EXCEPT PARKER WHICH IS 10% WITH A \$25 MINIMUM. If you sign up for full time and cannot attend ALL of the markets, please mark the dates that you **will be at the market** on the attached calendar.
- Part Time Application Fees are \$75.00 **per market**. Daily market fees are 10%, EXCEPT PARKER WHICH IS 10% WITH A \$25 MINIMUM. Mark **ONLY THE DAYS THAT YOU WILL BE AT THE MARKETS** on the attached calendar. Part time consists of ½ of the market season .
- Drop in Fees are 10% with a \$50.00 minimum each market attended. Drop in is 1x per month per market
- **BUSINESS BOOTHS ARE \$200 PER DAY, FLAT FEE, unless otherwise stated by management**
